PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY AND APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

IN ORDER TO BE CONSIDERED FOR ACCEPTANCE INTO THE 18TH DISTRICT COURT SOBRIETY COURT THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION MUST BE SENT VIA FAX OR EMAIL TO THE 18TH D.C. FOR REVIEW: FAX (734)238-1900 OR EMAIL (TCRAWFORD@18thDISTRICTCOURT.COM) FOR REVIEW BY THE 18TH D.C. PRIOR TO FORMAL ACCEPTANCE. You will be notified by the probation department via phone regarding your acceptance or rejection within 14 business days.

MUST INCLUDE ALL OF THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS IN EMAIL/FAX REQUEST:

- A completed referral form
- A copy of the plea agreement
- A copy of the Register of Action from the court requesting the transfer.
- A copy of the police report/accident report
- Criminal History
- Victim's contact information, if applicable

OTHER REQUIREMENTS WHICH MUST BE MET FOR CONSIDERATION:

- Must be convicted of 2 or more drinking and driving offenses.
- Must reside in Westland or boarding/adjacent communities
- Must be abusing alcohol or drugs and have the desire to stop
- Must admit to a substance abuse problem and are willing to participate in the program
- Are not currently on parole supervision, and criminal history does not include convictions for violent felony crimes and must not have a record of a sexual offense (past or present)
- Must be willing to abide by all requirements of Sobriety/Drug Court supervision, including attendance at substance abuse/mental treatment, attend 12 step support group meetings, attend all Court Review Hearings, Probation Appointments, submit to all alcohol and drug screens, and signing ISP Agreement and Waiver of Rights
- Must maintain monthly payments of \$100.00 to the 18th District Court.

PLEASE NOTE: Acceptance into this program is based on availability and capacity AND your requests for consideration for entry or transfer DOES NOT constitute formal acceptance until this Court reviews the case and makes such determination.
